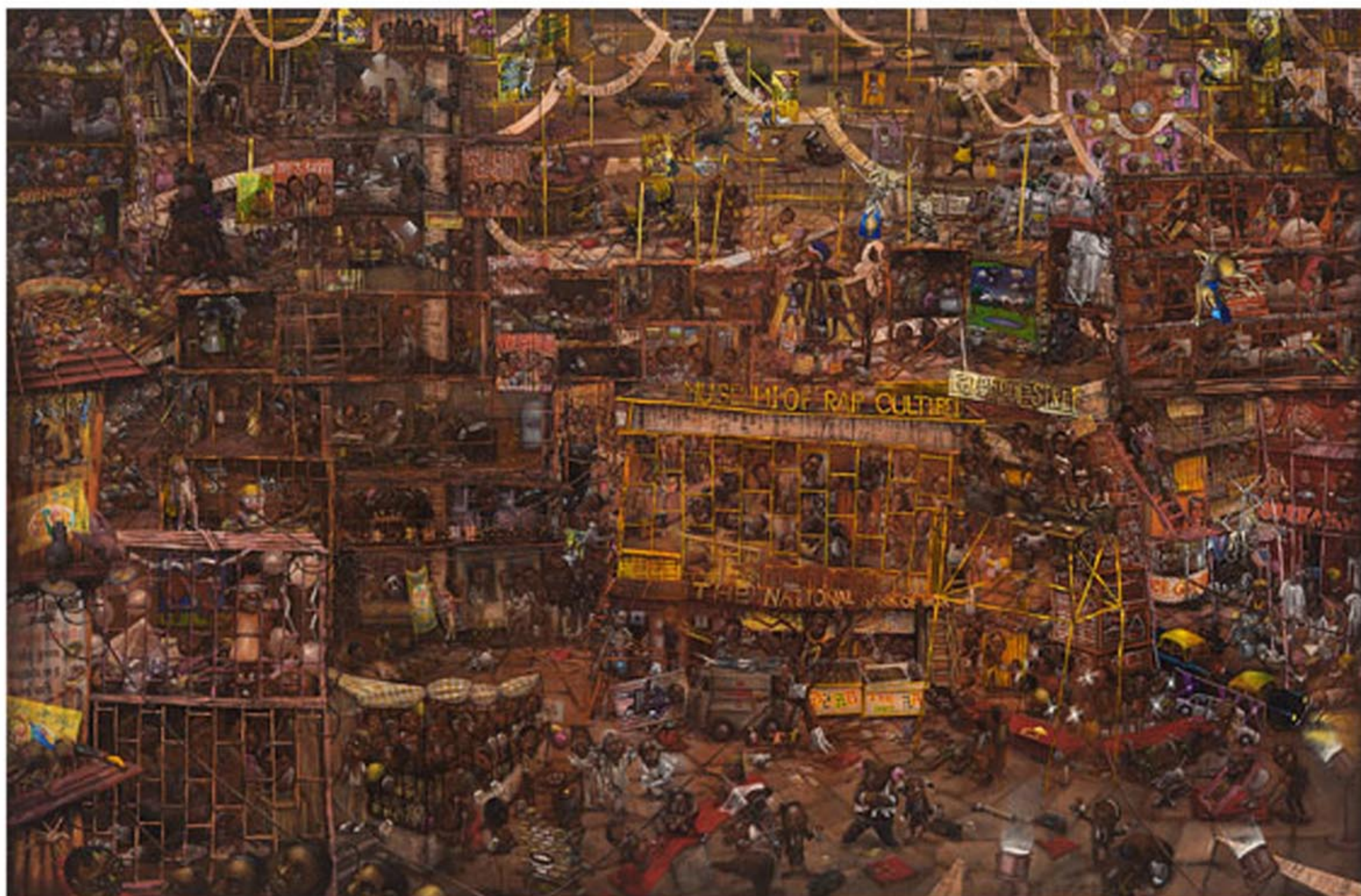




## Artist Cameron Hayes Paints Missing Link Between Sugarhill Gang and Hieronymus Bosch
