CHRISTINE HILL At Documenta X, she turned viewers into customers with "Volksboutique," a secondhand shop where you could buy a souvenir pencil or a vintage shirt. Now this radical artist—who lives her work and works her art—is conducting idiosyncratic walking tours. "Tourguide? Where Exactly Are We Going" turns participants into tourists. Its irresistibly tacky "visitor's bureau" transforms a gallery space into a storefront office—complete with bulletin board, banners, and other perfectly tuned paraphernalia. When she's not leading tours, Hill mans the desk, snagging savvy customers and an occasional passerby seeking hotel
