## Christine Hill: Pilot

Art & Museum Events: Installations, NYToday Pick

She calls them "organizational ventures." Blurring the line between art and real-life endeavors, Christine Hill's projects have included the opening of a second-hand clothing shop, the formation of a walking-tour agency in SoHo and the creation of a band that performed gigs in clubs in Germany and released a CD on Warner Music-Germany/Königshaus.

This time Hill masterminds the creation of a television talk show. At the Feldman Gallery, which has been transformed into a functioning television studio, gallery-goers may expect to encounter writers' meetings and technician and band rehearsals. "Pilot" also outlines the development of the host's persona and how guests are selected. The exhibition culminates on Oct. 6 with the filming of the premiere episode before a live studio audience.

Stay tuned for Hill's next "venture," a full-scale fashion show which will hit runways in Berlin in 2001. — Matt Muro
