

**★ HANNAH WILKE: INTRA-VENUS TAPES, 1990-1993** This show features 16 two-hour videotapes that Ms. Wilke and her companion, Donald Goddard, made during the last 30 months of her life, charting her spirited battle with lymphoma. The tapes could seem primarily like raw material for a documentary, but don't. Running simultaneously on a grid of 16 wall monitors, they immerse the viewer in the myriad details of another person's experience, a rare and astounding thing, especially under the circumstances.
